Multicultural Perspectives Public Speaking Competition Stage 3

Dear Stage 3 Parents & Carers,

This semester, Stage 3 students have the opportunity to participate in the **Multicultural Perspectives Public Speaking Competition** run by the Arts Unit of NSW Department of Education. In preparation, **students will present both a PREPARED speech and an IMPROMPTU speech in class** as part of our English Oral Language and Communication program. All students are expected to participate in class speeches.

The **prepared speech** must convey a multicultural message and students are to choose from the topics **below**. Prepared speeches should be 4 minutes in duration. Adjudication will be based on the matter, manner and method of the speakers. Stronger contestants will be confident and engaging, and speeches should have a balance of personal opinion with information, and humour with sincerity. The prepared speeches need to show an understanding of multiculturalism, but the impromptu speeches do not.

The **impromptu speech** will be on a **general, non-multicultural theme**. Impromptu speeches should be 2 minutes in duration. Students will practise this in class and be expected to deliver an impromptu at the Stage Final. Five minutes preparation time will be allowed for Stage 3 students. Equal consideration is given to the prepared and impromptu speeches. **Two representatives from Stage 3 will advance to the next level of the competition.**
