### CANBERRA/SNOW 2024

Dear Parents,

On Monday 1st, Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> and Wednesday 3rd of July a three-day study trip has been organised for Year 6 students to Canberra and the snow (Smiggins Holes). A detailed itinerary, dietary needs and medical consent forms will be sent out in coming weeks as the study trip approaches for your consideration.

During Terms 1 and 2, Year 6 students will be studying the processes of government in Australia, with a detailed look at Federal Government through our history syllabus. Therefore, the visit to Parliament House, Electoral Office and Old Parliament House constitutes a large part of the excursion time. Other places the students will visit are: - The Australian Art gallery, Institute of Sport, Questacon, National Capital Exhibition Centre and a drive past the embassies and the Lodge. The school has also added an extra day for the students at the snow.

***The Parliament and Civics Rebate program provides a travel subsidy for our students of \$30.00. This subsidy is used to offset part of our study trip to Canberra. (This is an initiative of the Commonwealth Government.)***

We will have a short comfort stop at McDonalds, Sutton Forest along the way and on the return journey. Some pocket money will be required.

The cost of the excursion is **\$490.00** per student. (Please speak with Mr Robinson if you require financial assistance.) This will include all meals [except lunch on the first day], accommodation, all admission fees and protective clothing from village ski hire. Two coaches have been booked for the entire grade to attend at the same time. The students will be staying at **the Capital Airport Motor**. (all linen, blankets and towels are provided).

Students will depart school at 7:00 am Monday and return 6.15 pm Wednesday.

If you would like your child to participate in the study trip fill in the permission note below and payment will need to be finalised by **Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June 2024**.

*A decision will be made by the School Executive in consultation with the class teacher about the attendance of any students who are currently on Behaviour Level 2 or Behaviour Level 3 of our School Discipline Policy at this excursion.*
