


School Performance South Primary Schools Public Speaking Competition 2021

Early Stage1 & Stage1 - a quarter of an A4 page

Stages 2 and 3 - an eighth of an A4 page.

- All competitors are required to deliver both a prepared and an impromptu speech at <u>every level</u> of the competition.
- Both the prepared and impromptu speeches are given equal consideration (50% each) for the overall marking at every level of the competition, including Early Stage 1.
