Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Please find below important information regarding Sydney North Dance Festival performances for the Stage 3 Dance Troupe.

Filming Session Information - Wednesday, 26 June 2021 at 10.10am

All students will need to meet in 6G's classroom at **8:00am** to change into their costumes. Students are to come to school with their school uniform on and full hair and makeup done (face paint will be done at school by teachers). Travel to and from the dress rehearsal is by bus. Once the students arrive back at school they will change back into school uniform and take their makeup off. Students may bring face wipes to take their makeup off. Students will be responsible for their own costume after this performance. It will be given to them in a labelled bag.

Evening Performances – Thursday, 17 June at 7:30pm, Sunday 20th June at 5:00pm and Monday 21st June at 7:30pm 2021.

All students are must arrive 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the concert. They are to be dressed in their costumes with complete hair and make-up done with a warm jumper over the top. Face paint will be applied once students arrive at the theatre. Miss Huggett and Miss Alcock will meet students in the holding room, near the car park at Glen Street Theatre. All parents are responsible for their child's own transport to and from the Glen Street Theatre. The performance will run for approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes. Teachers will walk the students to the bus stop directly outside the Glen Street Theatre car park, on Glen Street - opposite the shopping complex. This is to avoid all of the crowds and make it easier for children to be collected. Parents and caregivers are to meet their children here to take them home.

For the filming and performances, students should present as follows:

Costume: Pink, silver and black space themed dress with fishnet stockings.

Makeup: Full coverage, black mascara, black eye liner, bright extravagant eye shadow and rep lipstick.

Silver and black face paint will be added (provided by teachers)

Hair: Bubble Braids (pictures will be provided)

After the final show, students are welcome to keep their costumes. However they will need to wear them again later in the year for other performances.
