

## Year 7 2025 Expression of Interest Forms



Dear Parents and Carers,

In NSW Government schools, applying to move from primary school to high school is a 2-step process.

**Step 1:** The first step is to complete a Moving to high school expression of interest. When completing this form, you will be able to indicate which school(s) you would like your child to attend in Year 7.

**Step 2:** The second step is to submit an enrolment application, which will be issued to you by the high school after they have assessed your expression of interest.

**The online 'expression of interest' form for entry into Year 7 in 2025 is now available.** All students who are attending a government high school must have this form completed by a parent or carer by the 4th of April.

**If your child will be attending their local government school,** the expression of interest form will help you to locate your local government school based on your residential address.

**If your child will be sitting the selective schools placement test** (which you would have applied for at the end of 2023 if interested), you will need to complete this 'expression of interest' form. You must also indicate your local government school, as your child will be offered a position in their local school if they are unsuccessful in attaining a position in a selective setting. You can also indicate if you would like to be considered for an offer in a non-local government school.

**If you wish to submit a non-local area application for a government school,** you will be able to indicate this in 'the expression of interest' form. You will also need to complete the placement at your local government school section of the form, as your child will be offered a position in their local school if they are unsuccessful in obtaining a non-local offer. Many high schools also have additional requirements for non-local applications, so please ensure you contact those high schools to obtain any other necessary information.

**If your child will be attending a non-government school (such as independent or private school),** it is very helpful for us if you also complete the 'placement not required' aspect of the form to indicate which non-government school your child will be attending. You will still need to apply for enrolment to those non-government schools directly, but this information helps us to ensure that every current Year 6 student has a high school application.
