

On Monday, 11 November 2019, Russ the Story Bus, the Sydney Writers' Festival's beloved 'library -on-wheels' will be visiting Revesby Public School.

Russ the Story Bus is a magical bus for primary school students

that celebrates storytelling, reading and creativity, and encourages a lifelong love of books.

Each student taking part will be invited on Russ to select

a free book of their very own to keep, as well as take part in an interactive talk presented by a children's book author or illustrator. The author will share their love of books, discuss their craft and inspire children to think creatively about reading, writing and storytelling.

The author visiting Revesby Public is Frances Watts, an award-winning author of more than 25 books for younger readers. Her bestselling picture books include *Kisses for Daddy, Parsley Rabbit's Book about Books*, and *The Fearsome, Frightening, Ferocious Box.* Frances is also the author of the medieval Sword Girl series and the Stinky Street series (under the name Alex Ratt).
