## **NAPLAN Parent Information and Timetable 2024**

Dear parents and carers,

The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is an annual assessment for students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9. Students in Years 3 and 5 at BPPS will be sitting the assessments in **Weeks 7 and 8 (13-25 March)**.

If you have a child in either of these year levels, please avoid scheduling appointments during the test dates and move existing appointments.

If your child is away from school on an assessment day, they will be required to make up the test during the designated catchup days.

Please remember that NAPLAN is a snapshot test of how your child performs in one test on a particular day. We have the utmost confidence in our students and teachers. As parents, the best thing you can do is keep calm and ensure your child is well rested and given a healthy breakfast. Nothing is gained by being anxious or putting pressure on students. Remember 'errors are exciting, because they indicate a tension between what we *now* know and what we *could* know; they are signs of opportunities to learn' (Hattie 2012).

Please see the timetable below for NAPLAN 2023 for Years 3 and 5. Students must be at school and ready by 9 am. Some assessments have multiple sessions in the day. Ensure your child has their headphones at school.
