Stock & reorders

The Book Fair consists of a range of fun and exciting books, stationery and kits for all ages and stages. Stock will no doubt fly off the shelves over the week but rest assured that purchases can still be made even when a last copy of a particular item must stay on the shelf. These purchases will be put through as reorders and will be distributed to students once they arrive at school.

Payment options:

Payments in person (with a parent/carer) – card preferred

During the morning and afternoon sessions parents can use tap-and-go credit and debit cards to pay for purchases. Card is the preferred payment method, however if you wish to use cash, we ask that you bring exact or near the desired amount to be purchased.

For example, should you wish to purchase a \$17 item a twenty-dollar note would be the preferred cash to pay with rather than larger notes requiring change. This way your child can choose some stationery items to bump up the total to the full value of the payment amount.

During library sessions – cash or pre-payment online

Pre-payment online (preferred option)

Parents/carers have the option of prepaying for purchases using the website on the back of the student Wish List slips. These slips must be handed in at the library along with purchase, to confirm that payment has gone through. Should items requested not be available, a reorder will be made where possible.

Cash

Students are allowed to bring cash to purchase items during their library sessions. Students are requested to bring the exact or near the desired amount to be purchased. This can be a great opportunity to teach students to be responsible with money, to keep it safe during the day and bring it to their session to pay for their desired purchases.
