

### **HSC TRIAL EXAMINATION TIMETABLE 2022**

ALL examinations will be in the exam hubs (N3.01, N3.02, N3.04, N3.05, N3.06, N3.07) unless otherwise specified.

Please arrive 15 minutes prior to the start time of your examination.

#### MARSDEN HIGH SCHOOL EXAM RULES AND PROCEDURES

- Students must be in <u>full school uniform</u> and follow the day-to-day rules of the school. If you are out of uniform you will be sent home to change. Depending on how long it takes for you to go home and return, you may miss examination time and affect your HSC School Assessment course ranking.
- Students are required to be outside the exam room <u>15 minutes BEFORE</u> the start of the exam. Students must line up quietly, physically distanced and wait for directions from the supervising teacher/s to enter the exam room in an orderly manner.
- All bags are to be left in the fover area before entering the exam room. Do not to leave valuables in your bag.
- Students are to carry all equipment required for the examination in a clear plastic sleeve. THERE IS TO BE NO

**BORROWING DURING THE EXAMINATION**. **NO** pencil cases, dictionaries, mobile phones, smart watches, count up/down timers or electronic devices (excluding calculators) are allowed. **NO** whiteout or correction tape is to be used on exam answer papers. Clear plastic water bottles without labels are allowed in the exam room.

#### **MOBILE PHONES**

Mobile phones are not permitted in the exam centre. Please place your phone in a clear snaplock bag labelled with your full name and hand to the examiner or Deputy prior to entering the exam room

#### ILLNESS/MISADVENTURE

Stay at home if you are unwell and seek out a medical certificate, follow illness/misadventure procedures as per the school's assessment policy. Illness/misadventure forms are available on the school website – follow the path Learning at our School/Assessment and Reporting/Illness misadventure application. A PDF is available to download & print.

### **COVID** and general illness

Maintain physical distancing when lining up and walking in/out of the examination room and with all staff supervising exams. Practise good hygiene; this includes washing hands for 20 seconds and using hand sanitiser at regular intervals, coughing and sneezing into your elbow or a tissue. Dispose of tissues quickly. If unwell before an exam, stay at home and seek medical certificate. If unwell during an exam, immediately report to the supervisor.

### **TOILET BREAKS**

Students should go to the toilet before entering the exam room. The toilet register <u>MUST</u> be signed by students <u>EACH</u> time they use the toilet during an exam. A teacher will need to escort you to the nearest bathroom. Just put up your hand and wait until the teacher is available to assist you.

#### **DURING THE EXAMINATION**

Students must **follow all instructions** given by the supervising teachers.

Students MUST NOT COMMUNICATE IN ANY FORM with other students or talk/make noise after entering the hall.

- Once seated, students must complete the attendance slip.
- No paper is to be brought into or taken from the examination room, including the exam paper.
- Students must write their name on top of every booklet they use.
- Students must not leave the examination room until the scheduled end of the examination. If you have completed the examination early, you must remain seated and quiet until the examination has finished.

### **CONSEQUENCES**

If you do not follow rules and you are involved in malpractice during the examination, you may be asked to leave the examination room and be directed to the Deputy Principal. Consequences may include disqualification from the exam, implementation of the school discipline code and communication with parents or guardians.

#### **EXAM EQUIPMENT**

- Write in black or blue pen only. Bring spare pens to each exam
- Bring stationery in a clear plastic sleeve.
- You may also bring: a ruler, highlighters, pencils (should be at least 2B) and sharpener
- a bottle of water in a <u>CLEAR</u> bottle. You can wear your <u>analogue</u> or <u>digital</u> watch to your exams but not a smartwatch. Once you sit down you will have to take it off and place it in clear view on your desk.
- You are not allowed to borrow equipment during exams. <u>All equipment you bring is subject to inspection on entry</u>. Make sure any equipment you are allowed to bring, such as a calculator, is in good working order because an appeal under misadventure provisions for equipment failure will not be upheld.
- To further clarify what you <u>cannot</u> bring into the exam room: ANY electronic device (no mobile phones, smart watches, countdown timers, earphones, tablets or laptops, music players, electronic dictionaries and communication devices. You <u>cannot</u> bring paper or any printed or written material. You can ask your teacher or presiding officer for working paper. No print dictionaries, except where permitted in language exams. No correction fluid or tape.
