- Keep membership list, motions register and assets register up to date
- This is an executive committee position.

### Fundraising Coordinator (VP)

- Discussing fundraising options and
- opportunities at P&C general meetings
- Coordinating volunteers to assist with events/activities
- Creating flyers and event notices

- Assisting and supporting the P&C and School Principal in the development of grant proposals

This is a Vice President role, which acts in support of the President and engages in

executive discussions.

### Uniform Shop Coordinator (VP)

- Oversees the operation of the uniform shop (including open hours and online sales)
- Manages stock levels
- Ordering stock to maintain supply
- Liaises with school office and suppliers
- Responds to parent/guardian enquiries
