Temporary Workforce Transition Initiative

In May this year, the NSW Government announced a plan to make an offer of permanent employment to at least 10,000 temporary teachers and school support staff.

Eligibility is based on school-based employees including teachers and all support staff who have worked in the same school on a temporary basis for 3 years or more, at the same classification, are engaged in a 12-month contract with that school for 2023 and are eligible for permanent employment.



We are so excited to announce that Mrs Coughlan, Miss Lamb, Mr McCrae and Mrs Bateman will now be permanent members of the Tower Street PS team and we could not be more delighted to be welcoming these exceptional educators to our school as part of this initiative!



We're thrilled to announce that we have received a 2023 Woolworths Junior Landcare Grant for our project, 'Tower Street Public School Crunch and Sip Garden.'

School Parliament's Environment Committee and SRC members will be busy designing and establishing a fresh food garden. Students will top up garden beds with new soil and assemble sturdy netted covers for protection from birds, cats and insects. They will plant an array of fruit and vegetable seedlings and maintain them until they are ready to be harvested. The Tower Street Public School Crunch and Sip Garden will provide all students with an opportunity to taste test healthy, fresh, home-grown fruits and vegetables.

Our school is one of 1,107 primary schools and early learning centres across Australia to receive a Woolworths Junior Landcare grant to help grow our next generation of environmental champions.

The students and Mrs Probert are looking forward to getting their hands dirty and learning from this project – we'll keep you updated!
