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

# From The Principal's Desk

I would like to extend a huge thankyou to all the parents and families who came to the fete on Saturday to enjoy what was on offer. It was a remarkable day and testament to the massive effort of the fete committee. Special thankyou to Karla, Suzie, Helen and name, who worked tirelessly throughout the day and for many months leading up to the event. Congratulations on such a well organised and successful fete.

Our school continues ever onward and although there have been many activities one this term the student learning is still integral. Above are a graphs representing the Kindergarten growth in reading.

You have the first graph which shows their starting point in term 1 and the most recent one for last week. The expected standard is at the end of Kindergarten for students to reach leavel 6-8



The School has also received the overall NAPLAN results for 2017.

Our growth between year 3 and 5 far exceeded the state Average in Numeracy, a focus for our school 3 year plan. 92% of year 3 exceeded the expected growth. The State average growth was 97.9 whilst the School achieved 131.7 average growth.

Our Spelling results also have continued to improve with 702% of students above the expected growth. The State average growth was 90 whereas PWPS

achieved 107.2. This has also been a focus of the school.
