Check-in assessment for Years 4 & 6

This week and next week students in Years 4 and 6 are participating in the Check-in assessment.



The Check-in assessment is a NSW Department of Education online literacy and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor student learning.

The assessment can supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs. Students with disability may receive the same level of support during the assessment they would normally receive in the classroom.

The students have or will complete a Reading and Numeracy assessment.

units of society, as well as its concern regarding their situation around the world. As part of our service philosophy at Rosehill PS





Preschool, we recognise that families are their children's first and most influential teachers, and we value the knowledge and skills that they impart on their children and bring to our setting.
