
Special Events:

Haya's Results at the Australian Schools Athletics Championships

Overall, Haya Dagher had some very pleasing results in all of the races she competed in at Nationals.

In the 12 Year Girls Multiclass she placed 5th and 7th in the 200m and 800m distances respectively, breaking an Australian National Record for a T12 athlete in the 200m with a time of 39.01. Haya was also selected to run in the NSW relay teams where she collected a Bronze medal for the 4x100m 10-12 Year Girls Multiclass Relay and a Silver medal for the 10-12 Year Girls Multiclass Medley Relay. Some amazing results over the 5 day event window.

We wish Haya the best of luck as she continues her athletics journey in high school next year. Another huge thank you to all of the parents and students who contributed to Haya's travels to Nationals, it was greatly appreciated.
