Smoothie Making

The children participated in some healthy smoothie making this week. They helped to chop up some strawberries and bananas and watched as the educators added the milk, yoghurt and honey into the blender. The smoothies turned out to be delicious and promoted discussions about healthy eating and scientific thinking about how the blender works. Educators plan these experiences for children to develop independent eating skills and promote a sense of responsibility and self-help. Cooking experiences also afford children with authentic opportunities to build their literacy and numeracy skills in a fun context. You can encourage your child to help you with some simple jobs in the kitchen at home, such as chopping fruit or veggies with child-safe utensils, drying the dishes and setting the table.

Winners and finalists will receive a certificate at the end of year K-2 presentation day assembly.



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


World Teacher's Day 2022
