## **PRINCIPAL'S REPORT**

It was a smooth resumption to normal classes last week. I am so pleased that we have our students back on site and in their classrooms. Teachers have done an amazing job getting students back into routine. I thank the teachers for all their efforts. Staff are also working hard to ensure that everyone stays safe. In the case of a COVID outbreak, schools are still closing at the moment for 24 hours (sometime it can be 48 hours). This allows an opportunity for a deep clean and for contact tracing to take place. Please ensure that you do not send your child to school if they are unwell.

Thank you to all the children for wearing their hats. I have noticed a significant improvement in the number of students wearing their hats daily. This is most pleasing to see, particularly as the weather heats up. A reminder to parents, please ensure that your child has a blue BPPS hat to wear at school. These hats are available to purchase online from the Uniform Shop.

Over the past week, several children have been arriving at school and are in the playground, unsupervised before there is a teacher out on duty. Our supervision of the playground does not begin until 8:50am. This is a significant H&S issue. Please do not send your child to school before supervision of the playground begins.

I understand that change, including a new class and teacher, can be an anxious time for both student and parent. Be reassured that our teachers will spend a lot of time towards the end of this term forming the 2022 classes. These draft lists will be carefully compiled. Please note, I will not consider any request for students in regard to placement in a composite class. All students in the school will experience both single year/grade and composite classes during their seven years at Boronia Park PS. Effective and high-quality learning programs and activities are taught in all classes. Every classroom teacher differentiates programs teaching reading, writing and number to satisfy the learning needs of the student.

In addition, we will also not consider any requests for students to be placed with friends or teachers. Students

benefit from being in classes with different students each year. They may be disappointed in the first few days, but they will make new friendships when faced with a different set of peers in their new class. This experience helps build personal resilience, a necessary trait for children as they grow.

Kindergarten 2022 will have their first of two Orientation Days tomorrow. The next Orientation Day will take place the following Tuesday, 9 November. I am looking forward to seeing lots of excited children come through our gates to begin what will be the start of their education journey. Tonight, an information session will be held for kindergarten parents in lieu of our normal meeting in the hall whilst the new Kindy's are at school. I look forward to seeing many parents via zoom this evening. Thank you to Mrs Parr for organising this very important event.

#### YEAR 1 PHONICS SCREENING CHECK TERM 4 WEEK 5

All Year 1 students in NSW DoE schools will be required to complete the mandatory Year 1 Phonics Screening Check from 2021. The Year 1 Phonics Screening Check is a quick assessment that tells teachers how your child is progressing in phonics.

Phonics is important for students who are learning to read. This screening check observes how your child can read words with different letter combinations.

The main purpose of the Year 1 Phonics Screening Check is to provide your child's teacher with information which will allow them to plan for your child's learning.

Each child is individually assessed by a teacher and all Year 1 students will be assessed.
