Year 10 Study Skills Seminar with Dr Prue Salter

This week Dr Prue Salter from Enhanced Learning Educational Services (www.enhanced-learning.net) ran a study skills session with Year 10. The main area covered for Year 10 was the importance of using this year as a training period to prepare for senior studies. Students need to learn how to work effectively at home, manage distractions, make brainfriendly study notes and work out which study techniques work best for them. Year 10 students also have a self-evaluation quiz to complete which will give them an indication of how ready they are for senior studies and what areas they need to work on. Parents are encouraged to review the handout from the session with students and discuss the main areas identified where changes need to be made.
