Maths Olympiad

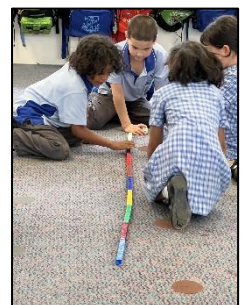
