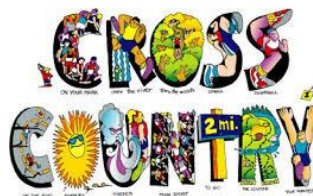


YEARS 3 – 6 CROSS COUNTRY
