Mrs Rhonda Morton has chosen to extend her leave into next term. I am honoured to remain in the role of Relieving Principal until the end of term 2.


Have a safe and relaxing break over the holidays. School resumes for students on Tuesday 30 April.



As a parent or carer, you are an important part of our school community. We know that you play a crucial role in helping your child become a motivated learner. Communication between our school and our community is critical for us to partner together.

To give our teachers the opportunity to recharge, spend time with their families and bring their best creative selves to work, we are setting clear expectations for when and how they respond to communication outside school operating hours. Our staff will always stay in touch because open communication is what's best for your child and their education. We don't want you to stop communicating with your teachers – we still want to hear from you if you have any questions or need to discuss a matter about your child. We know it's often easier to send emails or messages after work. We will make sure we read and respond in school operating hours.

## **Anzac Day**

On Thursday, Year 6 took charge of an Anzac assembly, guiding the school in honouring the brave individuals who have served to protect Australia. If we are the school with the most entries, we will win \$500 for the school!







## **Creative Kids Vouchers**

\$50 Active and Creative Kids Vouchers

The NSW Government is helping to make activities more affordable for eligible NSW families with the new Active and Creative Kids Vouchers program.

There are 2 x \$50 vouchers, issued in school term 1 and school term 3. To be eligible for the vouchers a student must be a resident of NSW, enrolled to attend a government or non-government school, or registered for home schooling in NSW during the 2024 school year and receive Family Tax Benefit Part A, or Family Tax Benefit Part B, or both. The vouchers are now available and can be redeemed at registered businesses before their expiry date.

Parents, carers, and guardians can apply for the Active and Creative Kids Vouchers via their MyServiceNSW Account, in the Service NSW app or website or by visiting a Service NSW Service Centre.

Vouchers will be provided as a downloadable QR code. They can either be used separately, or both vouchers can be redeemed in the same transaction (once the second voucher is available).

Each voucher can only be redeemed once. If the transaction is less than the amount of the vouchers redeemed, then the remaining balance is forfeited.



## **Primary Ethics**

Ethics is available at Coniston Public School for children in years 5 / 6. Ethics can also be available for children in years 1 / 2 / 3 / 4, depending on student numbers.

Ethics classes run in the SRE (Scripture)/SEE (Ethics) timeslot each week – on Wednesdays between 9am – 9:30am.



In ethics, students explore everyday issues suitable for their age. They learn to listen closely to each other, to disagree without putdowns and to think carefully as they form their own opinions through ethical reasoning. Ethics is for children of all faiths and none. Classes are free and are run by specially trained Primary Ethics volunteers.
