A message from Murat Dizdar, Secretary, NSW Department of Education 26 May 2025

Today on National Sorry Day, we pay our respects and acknowledge the Stolen Generations and the ongoing impact of historic government policies that caused profound harm to Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people – including historical education policies, where students were systematically excluded. It's a time for reflection, recognition and compassion as we commit to healing and building a more genuine relationship with Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people.

This year's theme for <u>National Reconciliation</u> <u>Week</u>, 'Bridging Now to Next', invites us to acknowledge past wrongs, to reconcile the past with the present, and walk together towards a more respectful and inclusive future.

Reconciliation is a shared responsibility and evident in <u>Our Plan for NSW Public Education</u>. The actions we take in our learning spaces and workplaces help create culturally safe, respectful and thriving environments for Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander learners, staff and communities.

At Coniston Public School, we commenced the week with a visit from Gumaraa. They imparted knowledge about bush tucker and artefacts, and taught us how to weave fishing lines and throw boomerangs. We also experienced both a smoking and ochre ceremony as well as some Aboriginal dances. Thank you, Ms Daly for organising this wonderful event.

On Thursday, our senior Aboriginal students attended the Walk for Reconciliation held at Bellambi Public School. We look forward to expanding our attendance at this event in 2026.

Walk for Reconciliation

Archie, Elena and Lamesha thoroughly enjoyed representing our school at yesterday's Walk for Reconciliation held at Bellambi. Joining with 40 schools and 2000 students, we walked along Cawley Street finishing at Bellambi Public School. Here we were treated to a welcome from Aunty Shaz, a smoking ceremony, a variety of performances, including dance, didgeridoo playing and singing, and a sausage sizzle (3000 sausages!!!).

Our students were all very impressed with the event and strongly support its expansion in 2026.



Time Tables Rock Competition

During Week 3, students in Years 4 to 6 competed in the New South Wales Rocks times table competition. Coniston Public School placed 7th overall out of 94 schools. Competition was fierce with 3886942 questions answered collectively by 6403 students from more than 114 schools and 488 classes. Our best performing student, Isaac in Year 5, answered an amazing 5519 questions correctly! Well done to all students who engaged in the competition and made improvements in their recall and speed. Students have their own unique account and can continue to practise their multiplication and division facts at home.



Walk Safely to School Day

On 16 June, many children, parents, carers and pets took the opportunity to walk to school. Despite the rainy weather, we had more people than usual participate.

The primary purpose of Walk Safely to School Day is to provide parents/carers with the chance to talk to their child about road safety and ensure they know how to cross the road, where to stand at the traffic lights (back at least on metre) and to walk on the left of the footpath. With more and more pedestrians being struck by cars, it's never too early to instil good habits.
