



	Refers to works that can be completed without approvals or are largely replacements of existing signs or lines. Note: Council's own-source allocation for signs and line marking is currently fully committed. On this basis, Council is			
	unlikely to be able to proceed with pursuing short-term actions without grant funding support. Council plan on grouping			
Short	sign and line marking installations from several schools across the Wollongong Local Government Area as part of a delivery package seeking grant funding approval under Transport for NSW's Road Safety Program. Transport for NSW has			
	not announced dates for the next Road Safety Program. As such, Council is unable to provide any timelines on future			
	submissions at this point in time.			
Medium	Refers to recommendations which require consultation/approval with other agencies (i.e. Transport for NSW).			
	Recommendations, if supported after further investigation, will need to form part of projects to be included within future			
Long	Infrastructure Delivery Programs (IDPs). These works typically take several years to be prioritised, designed, funded, and			
Long	delivered. Noting that we also have >80 other schools which will also have long term priorities and a finite budget and			
	staff resourcing to deliver projects, some projects may not be delivered for 10+ years.			




















7. Summary of long-term recommendations
