The Junior Band treated K-2 with an amazing performance on Tuesday morning, showcasing their newly developed musical skills for the students to enjoy.



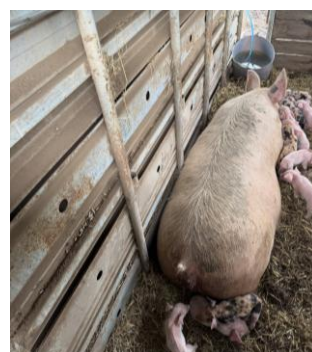
