





Principal's Message

I have been asked to remind parents about some road rules that may not be being followed in our local area. Please remember that following all road rules helps to keep everyone safe.







U-turns

You must not make a U-turn:

- at intersections without traffic lights where there's a 'No U-turn' sign
- at intersections with traffic lights, unless there's a 'U-turn permitted' sign
- across a single unbroken dividing line or double unbroken dividing line
- across double dividing lines with an unbroken line closer to you
- on motorways and freeways.

U-turn signs

There is a 'No U-turn' sign installed on the median island in Glencoe Avenue. 'No U-turn' signs are a regulatory sign and must be obeyed by law.



Remember, road rules are in place to protect all road users, and all motorists are expected to always follow the road rules.

Please be advised that Parramatta Police Area Command have been requested to patrol this area to deter illegal movements.

School Development Days

The last day for students in 2024 is Wednesday 18 December, followed by two School Development Days. The second of these days has been rescheduled due to the staff having completed at least six hours of Professional Learning outside normal school hours. The school office will remain open on both Thursday 19 and Friday 20 December if parents need to contact the school.

Due to the new Teacher's Agreement, the NSW Department of Education has extended the number of school development days to 8 throughout 2025.

Students do not attend on school development days.

School development days for term 1 for staff are Friday 31 January, Monday 3, Tuesday 4 and Wednesday 5 February. **Students start term 1 on Thursday 6 February 2025.**

The annual school swimming carnival for years 2 -6 will be held on Friday 7 February.

Term dates for 2025:

- Term 1: Thursday 6 February to Friday 11 April
- Term 2: Wednesday 30 April to Friday 4 July
- Term 3: Tuesday 22 July to Friday 26 September
- Term 4: Tuesday 14 October to Friday 19 December

Class Placement 2025 - Parent/carer requests in writing

Class placement is an important and complex task which the school invests a lot of time and planning in. Parents and carers are welcome to provide written information by letter or emailing the school. Please have these to me by Monday 2 December 2024 should there be specific considerations or information about your child/children you would like the school to be aware of when forming 2025 class placements.

These may include:

- social and emotional needs
- academic ability consideration for additional extension or remediation
- behaviour and past relationship issues that you feel have impacted your child/children.

There are no guarantees all considerations can be implemented due to our limited classes, but please be assured that the Executive, the staff and I always plan classes with the best educational and wellbeing outcomes at the forefront of determining class placements for every student.

Kindergarten Enrolments for 2025

Please Enrol Online as soon as possible

Parents who have children wishing to commence Kindergarten in 2025 need to complete an application to enrol in a NSW Government School form. This form is available via the online enrolment process which can be found on our website or go to Online Enrolment Application (nsw.gov.au) or by collecting an enrolment form from the office.



If you reside outside our local catchment area you will need to complete an Out-of-Area Enrolment for Burnside Public School (also available online at Online Enrolment Application (nsw.gov.au) or in a paper form) and then you will be placed on our waiting list. All siblings need to ensure this process is completed as soon as possible so we can establish if we have additional space for out of area enrolments.

If you have neighbours or friends that maybe interested in coming to Burnside next year, please direct them to the school website or invite to come up to the school office.
