Extra-curricular activities may incur a fee, such as excursions and sport. 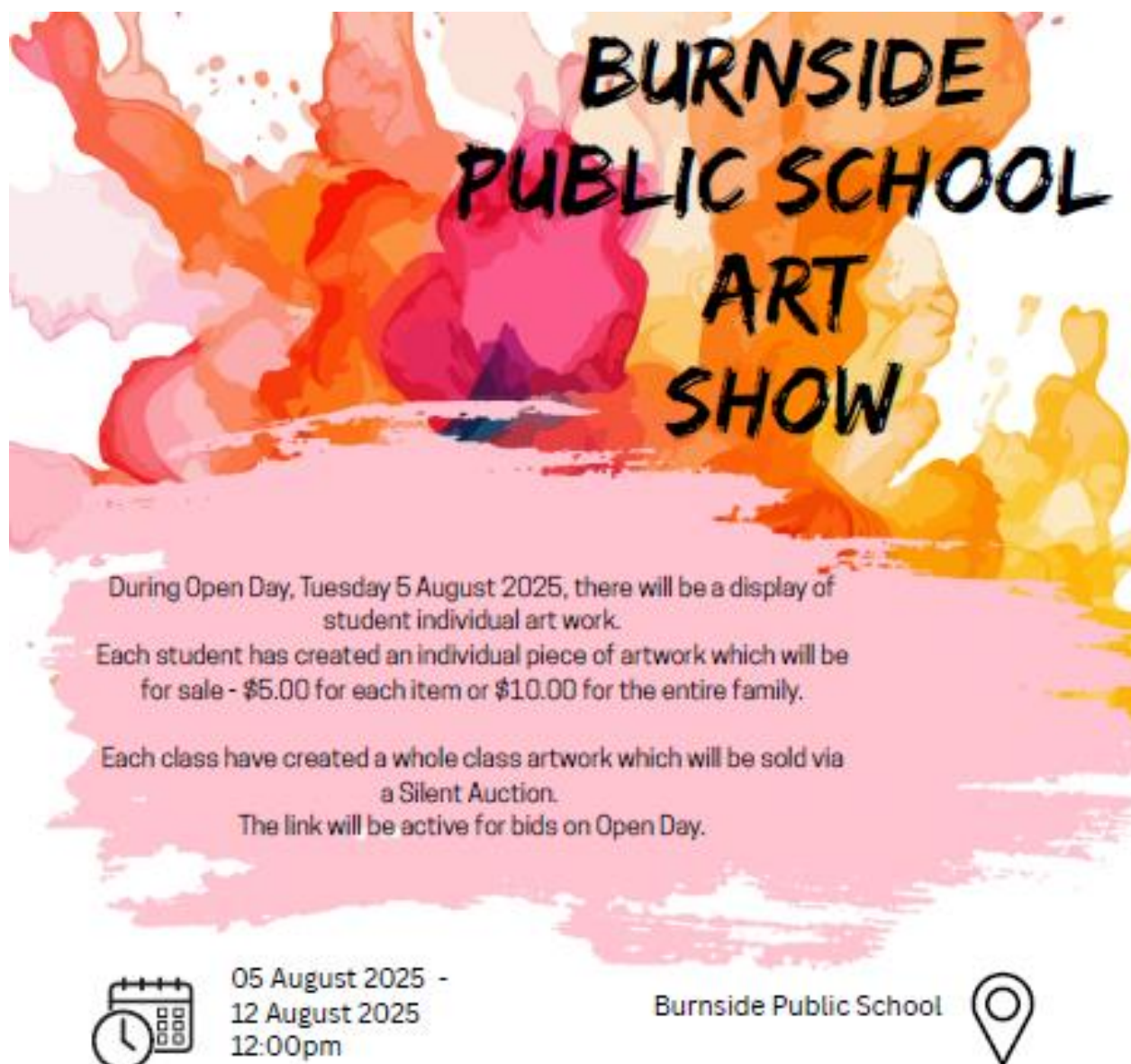

Each student has created an individual piece of artwork which will be for sale - \$5.00 for each item or \$10.00 for the entire family.

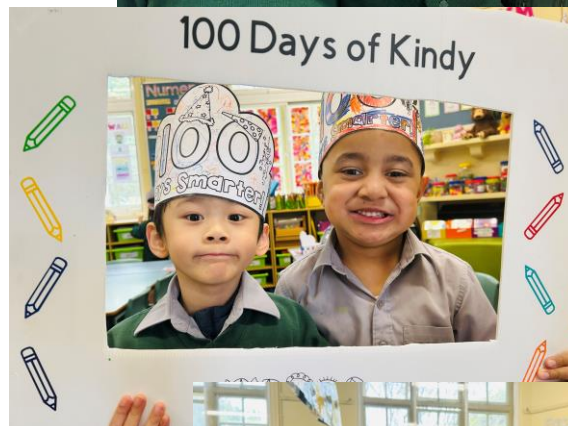
Each class have created a whole class artwork which will be sold via a Silent Auction.

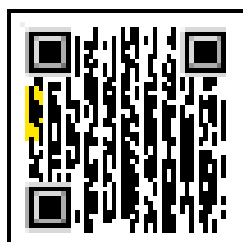
Scholastic Book Fair Pre-Payment

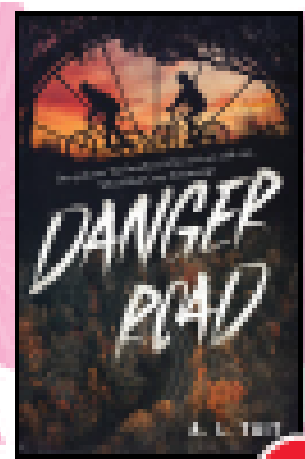

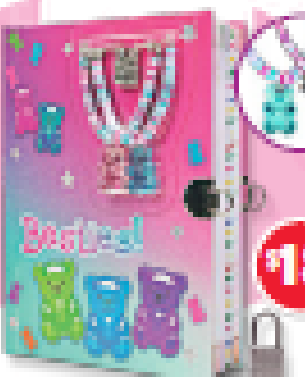
