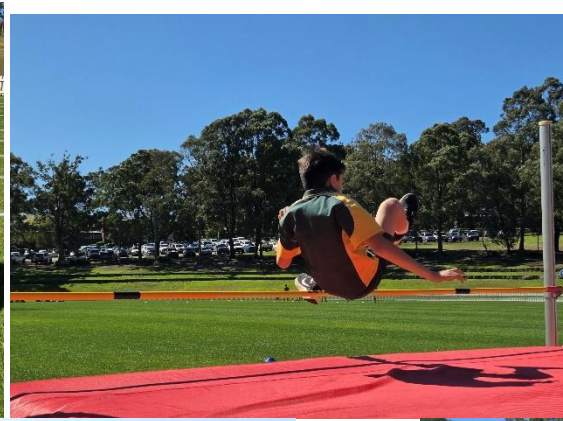
Western Sydney Debating Team

Soccer Sr Red lost 1-5 against Parramatta PS. Sr Blue won 3-0 against Parramatta PS

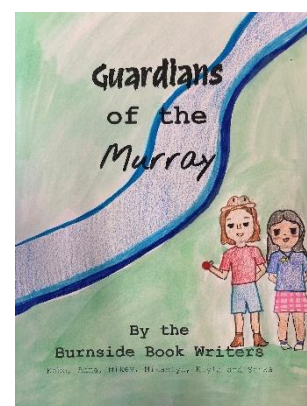
