Kindergarten Enrolments for 2025

Please Enrol Online as soon as possible

Parents who have children wishing to commence Kindergarten in 2025 need to complete an Application to enrol in a NSW Government School form. This form is available via the online enrolment process which can be found on our website or go to <u>Online Enrolment Application (nsw.gov.au</u>) **or** by collecting an enrolment form from the office.



If you reside outside our local catchment area you will need to complete an Out-of-Area Enrolment for Burnside Public School (also available online at <u>Online Enrolment Application (nsw.gov.au</u>) or in a paper form) and then you will be placed on our waiting list. All siblings need to ensure this process is completed as soon as possible so we can establish if we have additional space for out of area enrolments.

If you have neighbours or friends that maybe interested in coming to Burnside next year, please direct them to the school website or invite to come up to the school office.

Earn and Return



Support Burnside P&C by Recycling: Consider Burnside P&C when recycling your eligible cans and bottles.

As a new option we now have 4 yellow bins so you can drop off your eligible cans and plastic bottles (no glass!) near the hall for P&C to return on your behalf.

Please consider helping the school in this manner.

The app option is still available.

Here's how it works:

- 1. Download the Return and Earn app from Google Play Store or Apple App Store.
- 2. Search for your favourite charity under the "CHARITIES" menu.
- 3. Press on its tile, scroll down, and select 'Set as payout'.
- 4. Scan your app at your local Return and Earn machine or automated depot (using Tag and Drop).
- 5. Return your containers and press "TRANSFER" on the machine screen or follow the steps on the Tag and Drop screen at an automated depot.

Burnside PS will receive a full **10c** donation per can or bottle.

Delivery Schedule: Uniform deliveries are on Tuesdays and Fridays, except for urgent items like hats.






