Premier's Spelling Bee

During Term 2, students in years 2-6 will be given the opportunity to participate in the 2025 Premier's Spelling Competition. This competition is open to all NSW government schools for Year 3-6 with Year 2 welcome to participate.



Each class will conduct spelling bee practices and then a class spelling bee final to decide on finalists from each class.

The representatives selected from each class will compete in either the Stage 2 (Year 3 & 4) or Stage 3 (Years 5 & 6) school spelling bee final in Term 2 Week 9. The winners from the school final will represent Burnside Public School at the Regional Spelling Bee in Term 3 Weeks 4 or 5. We will be notified of the exact date closer to the event.
