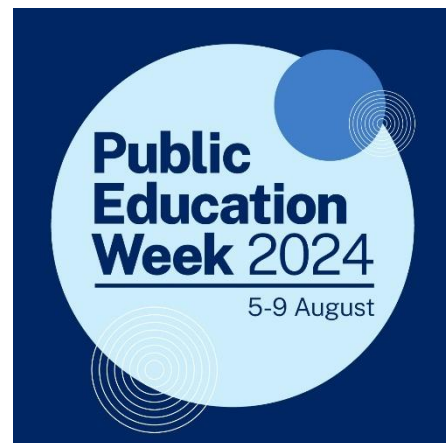
Principal's Message

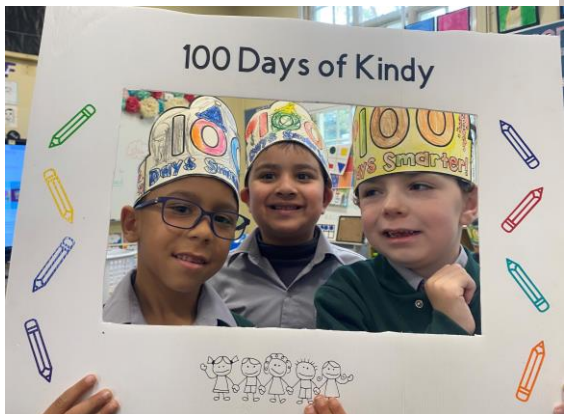

On Wednesday Burnside had a wonderful time celebrating NAIDOC week with two **Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people**. We had a lot of fun with the two Indigenous people who came to our school and taught us their traditional dances and part of their language. Ryka and Mo taught us many dances that we all enjoyed such as the Sasha, the Kangaroo dance, which all the teachers had fun doing and many more. Each stage had a delightful time learning different dances and moves. They also showed us traditional clothes and items such as the didgeridoo and the cloaks made from pelts. We were also shown how to operate the boomerang and how they created paint from ochre, by grounding up the ochre and mixing in some water. All the children had fun dancing and learning about their traditional culture, and some lucky students got some ochre painted on their face. Written by Emily.

This form is available via the online enrolment process which can be found on our website or go to [Online Enrolment Application \(nsw.gov.au\)](https://www.nsw.gov.au/online-enrolment-application) or by collecting an enrolment form from the office.



If you reside outside our local catchment area you will need to complete an Out-of-Area Enrolment for Burnside Public School (also available online at [Online Enrolment Application \(nsw.gov.au\)](https://www.nsw.gov.au/online-enrolment-application) or in a paper form) and then you will be placed on our waiting list. All siblings need to ensure this process is completed as soon as possible so we can establish if we have additional space for out of area enrolments.

Earn and Return



Support Burnside P&C by Recycling: Consider Burnside P&C when recycling your eligible cans and bottles.

As a new option we now have 4 yellow bins so you can drop off your eligible cans and plastic bottles (no glass!) near the hall for P&C to return on your behalf.

Please consider helping the school in this manner.

The app option is still available.

Here's how it works:

1. Download the Return and Earn app from [Google Play Store](#) or [Apple App Store](#).
2. Search for your favourite charity under the "CHARITIES" menu.
3. Press on its tile, scroll down, and select 'Set as payout'.
4. Scan your app at your local Return and Earn machine or automated depot (using Tag and Drop).
5. Return your containers and press "TRANSFER" on the machine screen or follow the steps on the Tag and Drop screen at an automated depot.

Burnside PS will receive a full **10c** donation per can or bottle.
