Road Safety

Please discuss the importance of using the pedestrian crossing on Mason's Drive as the only safe way to cross the road without a parent. Only students accompanied by their parent or carer should cross at the lights at the top of Mason's Drive, cars come around that corner very quickly and do not always check for children.

School Uniform

Just a reminder that all students should be wearing all black shoes with their school uniform. Trainers with other colours on them are only to be worn on Fridays with the sports uniform.

Please check that your child's jacket and hat are clearly labelled, so that they can be returned to them easily. The Lost Property Box is no longer at the end of the corridor. All lost property can be sent to the office to be given back to the students. If there is no name on the uniform this will not be possible.

Absences & Early Arrival or Late Pick Up

If your child is absent from school, please contact the office by phone, email or the school app so that absences are recorded accurately with the corresponding reason. If your child is late, please contact the office by phone or email or come to the office with your child.

Students should not be at school before 8.30am as there is no supervision in place. If your child needs to be dropped at school before this time, please arrange for them to attend Before School Care. There is a brochure at the office that has all the registration details for parents.

If you are going to be late picking your child up on a rare occasion, please contact the office if it is only a few minutes. If it will be a longer period, please arrange for them to attend After School Care, as staff should not have to supervise students after 3.15pm.
