Kindergarten Enrolments for 2025 – Please enrol as soon as possible

Parents who have children wishing to commence Kindergarten in 2025 need to complete an Application to enrol in a NSW Government School form. This form is available via the online enrolment process which can be found on our



website or go to Online Enrolment Application (nsw.gov.au) or by collecting an enrolment form from the office.

If you reside outside our local catchment area you will need to complete an Out-of-Area Enrolment for Burnside Public School (also available online or in a paper form) and then you will be placed on our waiting list. All siblings need to ensure this process is completed as soon as possible so we can establish if we have additional space for out of area enrolments.




