There are some students consistently arriving late to school each day, well after lessons have commenced. The beginning of the school day is extremely important as it is during

this time that Morning Routine takes place and classes begin Literacy sessions. Also, reinforcing





the importance of punctuality with students will greatly assist the development of good habits for later in life. Your support in ensuring students arrive to school on time, every day, is vital. If a child is ten minutes late every day, they miss approximately two weeks of education in just one year! The school bell rings at 9.12am every morning, giving all students an opportunity to visit the toilets, if required, and arrive at their classroom by 9.15am for the commencement of Morning Routine lessons. If your child is late to school, they must attend the school office for a late note prior to attending class.


