Parent Information Evening and Welcome Back BBQ

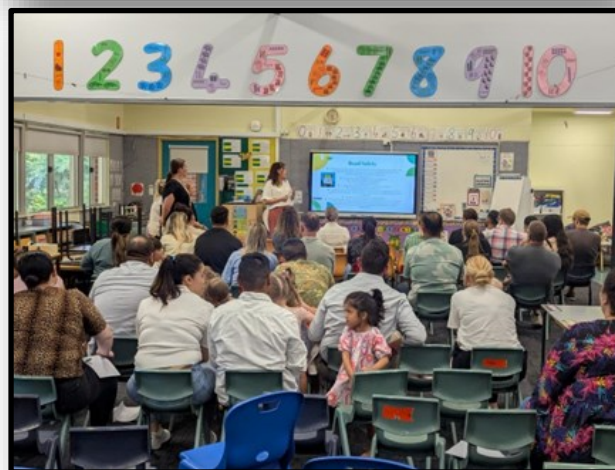
